2. Everything Else

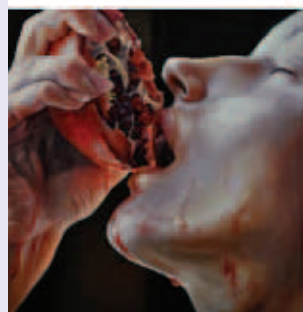
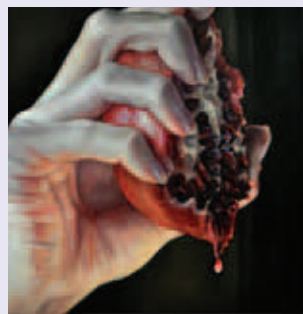
ARTIST - Get the brushes out and paint Historic buildings/homes, & Landmarks. or paint subject of your choice.

August 19 & 20, 2017

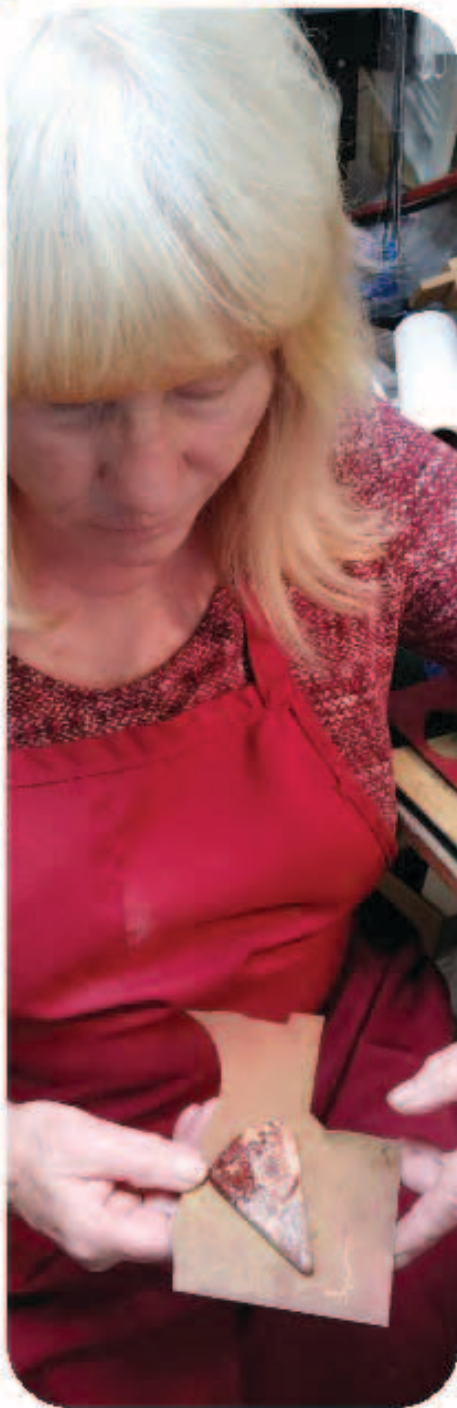

- 1. ARTISTS MUST CHECK IN JULY 2, 2017 BEGINNING AT 8AM TO HAVE CANVAS/ PAPER OR OTHER MEDIUM STAMPED WITH THE OFFICIAL LOGO BEFORE THE WORK BEGINS. STAMPING WILL BE DONE AT THE GALLERY AT 100 N. CALLE SEVILLE, SAN CLEMENTE.**
- 2. ONLY ART PAINTED IN "EN PLEIN AIR" DURING THE DAY FROM 8 AM TO 3 PM WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR THE JUDGED COMPETITION. NO STUDIO WORK.**
- 3. WORKS ENTERED FOR JUDGING MUST BE DELIVERED FRAMED AND WIRED FOR HANGING TO THE SAN CLEMENTE ART GALLERY BEFORE 3 PM.**
- 4. SIZE RESTRICTIONS: MAXIMUM SIZE INCLUDING FRAME MUST NOT EXCEED 24 INCHES ON ANY SIDE.**
- 5. OVERSIZE OR UNSTAMPED ENTRIES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
- 6. ART MUST STAY IN THE GALLERY FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW. IF ART IS OFFERED FOR SALE, 20% GALLERY COMMISSION AND SALES TAX MUST BE INCLUDED IN YOUR PRICING.**
- 7. PARTICIPATING SCAA MEMBERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN UP FOR ONE GALLERY SITTING SESSION.**
- 8. ONE PRIZE WILL BE AWARDED TO BEST IN SHOW. AMOUNT OF AWARD IS DEPENDENT ON THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS.**
- 9. FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS WILL BE SERVED AT THE AWARD RECEPTION.**
