James B. Proett, Artist

James was born in Santa Monica, California, and educated at Whittier College in Whittier, CA, There he earned a Masters Degree in Biological Science. He then went on to a D.D.S. degree from University of California Medical Center, San Francisco, He then embarked on a career in the U.S. Air Force which spanned nearly a quarter century and included extensive travel in Europe and the Far East. On his travels, he spent considerable time doing photography, both on land and underwater, where he won awards from the Pacific Stars & Stripes newspaper. At the end of his career, he settled in San Clemente. CA, where he has been to the present day. He has taken digital and traditional art classes over a period of some 10 years, earning certificates in Interactive Design and 3D Art. He has won several awards in South Orange County, both

ARTIST DEMONSTRATION

April 27th, 2025 - Debbie Morines - Plein Air Painter

Debbie Morines began her demo by sharing that, although she never attended art school, art had always called to her. Her story inspired confidence in us all. A longtime Kindergarten teacher, Debbie began pursuing art seriously in recent years, taking lessons—including her first from our own Alan Nowell, who was immediately struck by her talent.

Her confidence grew quickly, and opportunities soon followed—painting at weddings, corporate events, and even a Vans Skate-park gathering. "You never know where art will take you," she said.

Debbie's palette holds around 30 colors, always arranged in the same spots for quick access. She stressed that drawing is the foundation of any painting and demonstrated how holding the brush like a drumstick, not a pencil, adds a painterly quality.

Some of her favorite techniques include:

• Starting with darks using a mix of ultramarine blue + burnt umber for deep blacks.

- using gray + white + naples yellow for sunny rock highlights.
- Mixing unexpected sky colors—pink, orange, or viridian + white for pale blue, and manganese + cerulean for variety.
- Creating shallow ocean tones with cobalt + naples yellow + white, adding viridian for a minty hue, and transitioning to deeper blues with more cobalt.

Debbie worked on a Maui beach scene, which she'll finish and share soon.

Debbie teaches both group and private art lessons. Her warmth, talent, and practical tips made this a truly outstanding demo!
